*James Aldous was born in Harleston (Norfolk) on 7 February 1785
He married Harriette Poole in All Saints, Mendham, on 10 July 1809*

James Aldous died on the 1 May 1859 (74) and was probably buried at St Mary, Redenhall, though we have not located a grave there yet.
