James’ godparents were Charles Hampton and Samuel Hick (uncles) and Mrs Johnson (wife of the Rev Dr Johnson). Some of the earlier Hampton baptisms took place in Calcutta’s new Mission Church – beautifully written up and including godparent information – quite unlike this scruffy effort!!

James Hampton was born on 18 August 1784 at 1am. His mother Margaret died on Saturday 11 September 1784 at 6am aged just 35.
