wife”**

**James’ godparents were Charles Hampton and Samuel Hick (uncles) and Mrs Johnson (wife of the Rev Dr Johnson). Some of the earlier Hampton baptisms took place in Calcutta’s new Mission Church – beautifully written up and including godparent information – quite unlike this scruffy effort!!**

**James Hampton was born on 18 August 1784 at 1am. His mother Margaret died on Saturday 11 September 1784 at 6am aged just 35.**

- 9<sup>th</sup> Warren Hastings son of William Larkins Esquire, Broker Merchant in the Honble Company's Service, & Mary his Wife.
- 10<sup>th</sup> Ann, illegitimate Daughter of Matthew Howard, Surgeon.
- 11<sup>th</sup> Thomas Henry, son of Capt. Thomas Cell, Engineer, & Esther his Wife.
- 12<sup>th</sup> Sarah, an Orphan, & Catherine, aged about ten years, formerly servants of M<sup>r</sup> Jackson Widow.
- 13<sup>th</sup> Elizabeth & William, natural Daughter & Son of M<sup>r</sup> William Douglas Junior Merchant.
- 14<sup>th</sup> Lucy, Daughter of M<sup>r</sup> Henry Scott Senior Merchant.
- 15<sup>th</sup> Archibald, son of M<sup>r</sup> Archibald Montgomerie, Senior Merchant & Maria his Wife.
