

## Marriage Record – Presidency of Madras - 13<sup>th</sup> August 1807

### Lieutenant James Hampton marries Mrs Mary Forster

No record at all found in the transcribed LDS films. FIBIS transcribes the marriage from the EIRegister but with the wrong Presidency and month. After we had tracked the record in the Madras Marriages index file (Vol 3 p194) it was still a challenging task to find the record as the photo images were difficult to read and there were no page numbers! Still, we got there:
